- High School Graduating Seniors students are eligible to apply.
- Applicant must be a son/daughter of a steward of Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church of Palos Hills, IL for at least two years.
- An official transcript with the school's official seal- e-transcripts are acceptable.
- Two letters of recommendation:
  - 1) A teacher, advisor, counselor, dean, or coach on the school's letterhead.
  - 2) Applicant's choice from an individual who will provide character, dedication, and accomplishments
