Parish Council Officer Election Meeting following Divine Liturgy

Meeting was called to order by Fr. Tom at 11:40AM.

Fr. Tom offered prayer and opening comments. He then asked George Argires to facilitate the election of new Parish Council officers.

George Argires, as person designated to oversee the election of the Parish Council members, stated that 90 votes were cast. One ballot was disqualified because the ballot had votes for 21 individuals when only 20 could be voted on.

Three newly elected members of the Parish Council were absent: Tom Berchos, Janet Koliopoulos, and Mike Orrico. 17 members were in attendance.

George Argires went over the election rules for Parish Council Office. A voice vote would be conducted if there was only one person nominated for an office. If more than one person ran for an office, the vote would be conducted by secret ballot. To win, a person would need a minimum of 9 votes to win by a majority of those present at the meeting.

Fr. Tom read the duties of each office before nominations opened.

George Lattas nominated Jim Stavrou for President. Jim was voted into office by voice vote unopposed.

Angelo Fotopoulos nominated Andy Kladis for Vice President. Andy was voted into office by voice vote unopposed.

Gerry Galatis nominated Elaine Simadis for Treasurer. Elaine was voted into office by voice vote unopposed.

Andy Kladis nominated Gerry Galatis for Secretary. Gerry was voted into office by voice vote unopposed.

Fr. Tom read the process for electing a member of the Parish Council for the Executive Committee at Large position. This election will occur at the next Parish Council meeting.

Nominations were then opened for School Board Chair. Jim Stavrou nominated Elizabeth Chrystofilakis. Elizabeth was voted into this position unopposed by voice vote.

Meeting was adjourned at 12 noon.
