Requirements for Scholarship:

- High School Graduating Seniors students are eligible to apply.
- Applicant must be a son/daughter of a steward of Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church of Palos Hills, IL for a least two years.
- An official transcript with the school's official seal- e-transcripts are acceptable.
- Two letters of recommendation:
 - 1) A teacher, advisor, counselor, dean, or coach on the school's letterhead.
 - 2) Applicant's choice from an individual who will provide character, dedication, and accomplishments
- A list of activities and organizations you are currently or have previously been involved with in your school. (Sports, club memberships, volunteer work, band, drama, student council, National Honor Society, etc.)
- A list of activities and/or positions you have held in your parish, Saints Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church, Palos Hills, IL. Include the number of months or years associated and duties.


