SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS & POLICIES Of The SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS COMMITTEE

Please read the information below carefully.

The Saint Helen Women's Philoptochos has instituted a scholarship fund for the preservation and perpetuation of the Greek Orthodox Faith and the Hellenic culture. The goal of the scholarship fund is to assist male or female students from SS. Constantine and Helen Church of Palos Hills, Illinois. The scholarship is available to students planning to attend Hellenic College for undergraduate studies and/or Holy Cross Seminary on a full time basis.

ELIGIBILITY For SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be in good standing with SS. Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church.
- Applicant must be enrolled in a full time program at Hellenic College or Holy Cross Seminary.
- Students having less than one academic year remaining until graduation are not eligible for first-time consideration.

FACTS PERTAINING To SCHOLARSHIP

- The scholarship must be applied toward the cost of tuition, books, or room and board.
- If there are multiple students from SS. Constantine and Helen Greek Orthodox Church applying for the scholarship, the designated funds of \$4000 will be shared by those students. If there is only one applicant the scholarship amount is \$3000.
- Scholarships are awarded in two installments, 50% July 31st and 50% January 1st.
- Scholarship must be applied for annually. It does not renew automatically.

APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Completed application must be submitted by **August 1**, of the applicable school year.
